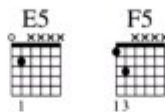

# 3 Basic Heavy Rock Rhythms

These are simple, basic heavy rock rhythms based on an E5 power chord. Notice how the rests in measures 1 and 6 contrast with the E5 power chord creating a stronger accent. In measure 2, the rhythm fills up when two eighth notes are followed by four sixteenth notes. An F5 power chord is introduced in measures 4 and 5, played with the same rhythm. This example ends with a sustaining E5 power chord.
